Technicians perform maintenance & repairs as noted on repair orders assigned to them by the Service Manager or Shop Foreman, documenting all work as completed.

Primary Duties & Responsibilities:

- Adjust, repair or replace parts and components of commercial transport truck systems including fuel system, brakes, steering and suspension, engine and drive train, emission control and exhaust, cooling and climate control, and electrical and electronic systems using hand tools and other specialized repair equipment
- Test and adjust repair systems to manufacturer's performance specifications
- Perform scheduled maintenance, such as safety inspections, oil changes, lubrications and tune ups
- Inspect or test mechanical units to locate faults and malfunctions
- Diagnose faults and malfunctions and confirm findings with supervisor to determine course of repair
- Record steps involved in repairs, general vehicle condition and note future repairs that may be required
